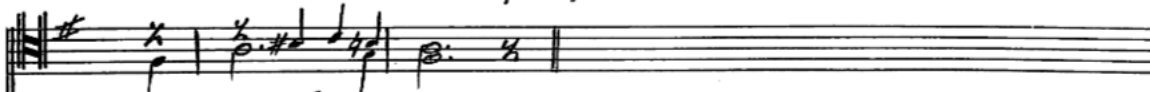
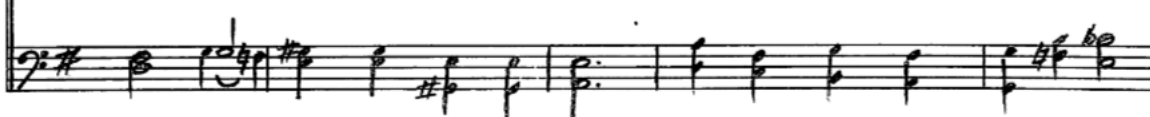
In the land of stran-gers, Whither thou art gone,

Come, and all is par-doned, My son! My son!

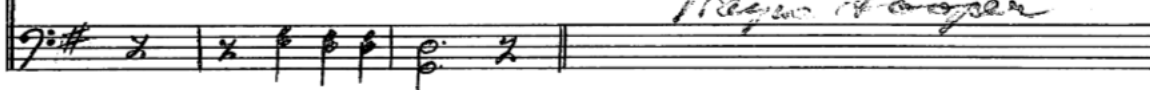
