**Thank You, Father, for Your amazing love.**







The Son of God loved me, and gave Himself for me. Galatians 2:20




1. I stand a-mazed in the pres-ence Of Je-sus, the Naz-a-rene,

5. When with the ran-somed in glo-ry His face I at last shall see,




And won-der how He could love me, A sin-ner, con-demned, un-clean.
