4. Take the world, but give me Je - sus; In His cross my trust shall be,

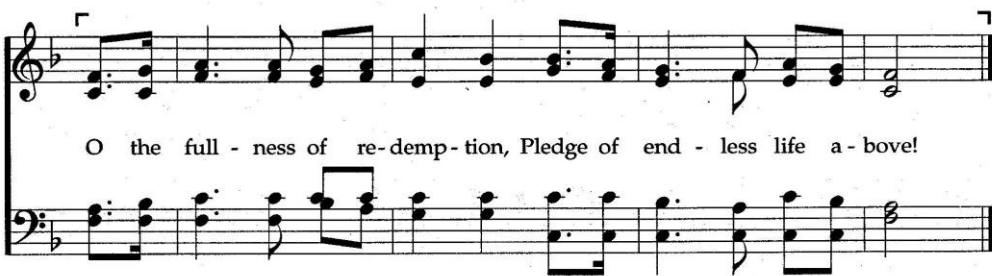


But His love a - bid - eth ev - er, Thro' e - ter - nal years the same.
