"Make a joyful noise unto the Lord, all the earth....and they that dwell therein." Inspired by these words from the 98th Psalm, Isaac Watts, an English preacher, penned the lyrics of this jubilant celebration of man's redemption. The melody is adapted from Handel's *Messiah*.

Even at night the desert is warm, though gentle breezes shift the dunes and rustle palm leaves. Tradition holds that despite the solitude, Melchior, Kaspar, and Balthasar feel compelled to press on, with only alight in the sky to guide them. They bring to Christmas more than frankincense and myrrh, for they show the worldwide impact of the First Christmas. Written in 1857, "We Three Kings" is considered by some critics to be the first totally American carol.

- BRING A TORCH, JEANNETTE, ISABELLA.....** 30

In Provence, in southern France, each villager's lighted torch fires the sky as townspeople join the procession to the church to view the nativity scene. This folk song evokes the excitement of children as they rush to the cradle: "Hush! Hush! Beautiful is the mother. Hush! Hush! Beautiful is her son."

The Jewish nation, bound by Roman oppression, pictured the Messiah as a liberator and longed for the deliverance his advent would bring. Followers of Jesus today also long for the reign of peace promised by his Second Coming. "O Come, O Come, Emmanuel" embodies the supplication of any soul yearning to be free.

- SILENT NIGHT** 50
(Mohr-Gruber)

It is 1818. The perfect Christmas song has not yet been found, Austrians Franz Gruber and Father Josef Mohr agree. Then one evening, Father Mohr is walking home after blessing a newborn child, and the majesty of the winter night overwhelms him. He writes his thoughts flowing rapidly from his heart into a poem. Because the church organ is broken, he rushes to Gruber's home and asks him to compose a melody on the guitar. The task is finished in less than an hour. Today, "Stille Nacht, Heilige Nacht," also known as "The Song from Heaven," is part of Christmas celebrations throughout the world.


